Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of a court of record, or by a supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, or process of a court of record, or by the act of the legislature, or by the act of the executive or judicial officer of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
