

Section 6614. Change in Title — Certification. When the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons, and the same is not in dispute, the auditor of the supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the court, or the auditor of the county, shall, upon the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
