Section 666.14. Change in Title.—Certification. When the title of any real estate is transferred by deed or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the court of appeals, the auditor of the county, by judgment, decree, will, process or otherwise, by clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said county, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
