Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons, and any real estate is transferred to any person or persons, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding or order in probate, the clerk of the court, or the auditor of the county, shall, at the cost of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
