Section 6614. — Change in Title — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment of a court of record, or by a decree of a supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by a judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the auditor of the county in which the land is located shall, upon the application of the person or persons entitled to the title, issue a certificate of title to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
