Section 898.14. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the clerk of said court, and the same is duly recorded, the judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the order of sale, or other proceedings of said court, or the clerk of the district court shall certify, the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
