Section 6661, k. Change in Title.—Registration. Where the basis of any judgment or decree of said court or of the supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by the judgment or decree of said court, the clerk of the court, or the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
