Section 626.14. Change in Title — Certification. When the person or persons having legal title to real estate in any person or persons in any county, or when title to real estate is changed by a probate court, or when title to real estate is changed by the clerk of the district court, in proceedings of order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify the change of title on the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
