Section 6641. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title to any real estate is changed by mortgage, or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by the operation of law, the auditor of said county, or the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
