Section 666.14. Change in Title.—Certification. When the title of a parcel of land is changed in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the supreme court, or when title to real estate is transferred by deed, will, or other instrument, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which the land is located.
