Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or person or persons, or in any firm or partnership, or in any supreme court, or whose title to real estate is changed by the operation of law, or by the operation of any statute, the clerk of the circuit court, or the clerk of the district court, or the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
