Section 602.14. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the judgment, decree, or will proceeding, or order in process, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
