Where the title may not seem to be a legal establishment of any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the court of appeals, or where title to real estate is conveyed by judgment, contract, or will, or where title is conveyed by the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
