Section 60614. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the name of the person or persons to whom the title or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the surrogate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment or decree of said court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment or decree of said court, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
