Section 606.14. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate owned by any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or by judgment, contract, or other title to real estate is changed by the clerk of the district court in response to a request by the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the which shall be filed, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is situated.
