Section 683.14. Change in Title — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person by a judgment, decree, order, or other judicial proceeding, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, probating, or other judicial proceeding, the auditor of the county in which the land is located shall, upon the filing of the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located
