Where the same or several estates are established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the probate court, or where title to real estate is conveyed by judgment or decree of said court, or where the same are certified by the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said real estate is located.
