Section 696.14. Change in Title.—Registration. Where the title of any real estate finally vests in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the court of appeals, or where the real estate is disposed of by judgment, decree, will, or otherwise, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
