Section 602.14. Change in Title. Confirmation. Where the title of any real estate is finally established by deed or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the court of appeals, and a change of title is desired by the judgment, decree or order of said court or of the court of appeals, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of the district court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
