Section 666.14. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment, decree, or order of the supreme court, or where title to any real estate is established by a judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the auditor of the county in which said land is located shall, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of this county, in which said land is located.
