Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the supreme court of this state, and the same is subject to the judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the seal of said court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
