Section 836.14. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title to real estate is changed by deed, mortgage or present or future judgment or decree of said court or of the supreme court, or where title to real estate is obtained by purchase, gift, or otherwise, the auditor of the county or the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
