Section 0614. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment, decree, or order in a court of record, or in a supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the auditor shall certify to the auditor of the county in which said real estate is located.
