Section 806-14. Change in Title.—Confirmation. Where the title or legal estate in real estate is held by persons or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the supreme court, or where title to real estate is claimed by persons or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the supreme court, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is situated.
