Section 866.14. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons, or where the same is finally established by the supreme court, or where title to real estate is obtained by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the auditor shall certify to the title so established in the field of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
