Section 665.1. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment of a court of record, or by a judgment of a supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the auditor of the county in which the land is located shall, upon the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
