Section 9814. Change in Title. — Certification. When the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a deed or other instrument, the title may be changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same to the county auditor, who shall cause the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
