Section 60614. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is changed by a decision of an appellate court or by a change of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, probate order, or other legal process, the auditor, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
