When the title to real estate finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the supreme court, or upon the sale of said real estate by the sheriff, or upon the sale of said real estate by the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said county, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
