Section 66814. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment of a court of record, or by a judgment of a supreme court, or when title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the auditor of the county in which said real estate is located, shall certify the fact of such change to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
