Section 88, 14. Change of Title. - Certification. Where the title of any real estate, family establishment, or person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a judgment of the supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by an order of the court, or where the same is produced, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same to the county auditor, or the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
