Section 6634. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title to real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or by the filing of a deed, or by the recording of a deed, or by the recording of a mortgage, or by the recording of a lease, or by the recording of a probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said title is shown.
