Section 63614. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any county in this State by a final judgment or decree of a court of record, or a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in any court of record, or by any other legal proceeding, the auditor under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
