Section 676.14. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is changed in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court is changed by judgment, court, or where title to real estate is transferred by deed, mortgage, or otherwise, the clerk of the district court shall certify, on order in writing, the date of the change, the name of the person or persons to whom the title is transferred, and the county in which said land is located.
