Section 6814. Change in Title. Application. Where the state or federal government, or any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or whose title to real estate is in dispute, or where the title to real estate is in dispute, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
