Section 6814. Change in Title. Confirmation. Where the state or county auditor is satisfied that the person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decree of an appellate court, or whose title to real estate is affected by a judgment or decree of the district court, is entitled to the same, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
