Section 60614. Change in Title.—Certification. Where
the person by whom any real estate is owned or
any person by whom any interest in said real estate
is held, or where title to real estate is changed by
judgment, court, or otherwise, the auditor of the
county in which said real estate is situated, under
the seal of the district court shall certify the same
under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in
which said land is located.
