Section 498.14. Change in Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court and such title is thereafter changed by a judgment or decree of the district court, the title of the district court shall serve as the basis for the title of the county in which said land is located.
