Section 666.14. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the court of appeals, or by judgment or decree of the court of appeals, judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of that district court shall certify the same, under the care of the county auditor, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
