Section 666, I. A. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally determined by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to said estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, deed, conveyance, or otherwise, the auditor of the county in which said land is located, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
