Section 695.14, Change in Title. Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a deed, and the title is thereafter changed by a judgment or decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, with a copy of the same, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
