Section 663.14. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title or ownership of any real estate, or any interest therein, or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the judgment court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, or where the title to real estate is changed by the clerk of the district court shall certify the same under the seal of said court to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
