Section 866.14. Change of Title.—Certification. When the auditor and county auditor certify to the clerk of the district court or by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decree of an appellate court, with or without a writ of certiorari or order in rem, that the title to land in a county is the same as shown on the records in the office of the auditor, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
