Section 636.14. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment, decree, will, probate, or order of a court of competent jurisdiction, or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, probate, or order in proceedings in equity, or by any other legal proceeding, the auditor of the county in which said land is located, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
