Section 6314. Change of Title. Certification. Where the title to any real estate is transferred by deed or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is transferred by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
