Section 606.14. Change in Title. Certificate. When the title of any real estate is transferred in any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or otherwise, in order to be effective as to persons so affected, the certificate of title, in the case of a judgment or decree, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
