Section 60214. Change in Title.—Registration. Where the title of any real estate is finally established by law or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by the clerk of the district court, and it is thereafter to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, or otherwise, the clerk of the district court shall enter the same in the county auditor's office, and the county auditor of the county in which said land is located
