Section 936.14. Change in Title. — Certification. When the certificate of title is issued, the auditor shall certify to the clerk of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is involved, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
