Section 6681k. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a judgment of a court of record, or by a judgment of a supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceedings, or order in pending litigation, the auditor of the county in which the land is located shall cause the title to be recorded in the office of the auditor of the county in which said land is located.
