Section 8634. Change in Title.—Certificate. Where the certificate of title is issued to any person or persons by a judgment or decree of the district court or by a decision of an appellate court, or where title to real estate is transferred by a deed, mortgage, or other instrument, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
